## SCHEDULE OF TARIFF CONCESSIONS OF BULGARIA

## Statement by the Director-General

After having participated in the tariff negotiations in the framework of the Multilateral Trade Negotiations (see document MTN/26/Rev.2) the People's Republic of Bulgaria has transmitted to the secretariat its Schedule of Tariff Concessions resulting from these negotiations. Two copies of the Schedule are being sent to each contracting party.

The Government of Bulgaria has declared that it is its intention to apply, in accordance with the terms set out below, the tariff concessions enumerated in the Schedule of Tariff Concessions of Bulgaria, annexed hereto, in respect of imports from contracting parties to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade which will accord to Bulgaria the same rights in respect of tariff concessions enumerated in their Schedules annexed to the Geneva (1979) Protocol.

- 1. The products enumerated in the Schedule of Bulgaria shall not be subject to customs duties and similar charges in excess of those set forth in that Schedule.
- 2. Bulgaria shall take no action that nullifies or impairs, directly or indirectly, the benefits accruing to exporting countries under paragraph 1 above.
- 3. Bulgaria shall apply the concessions enumerated in the Schedule in accordance with the principles of Article II, Article XIX, Article XXIV, Article XXVIII and Article XXVIII and other relevant provisions of the General Agreement.
- 4. Bulgaria shall implement the tariff concessions enumerated in the Schedule in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Geneva (1979) Protocol.

Bulgaria expects that full account be taken of the concessions granted by Bulgaria in the Multilateral Trade Negotiations if Bulgaria should at a later date decide to negotiate for accession to the General Agreement.
