NOTE BY JAPAN

The following communication has been received from the Permanent Delegation of Japan and, as requested, is being circulated for the information of all participants in the multilateral trade negotiations.

During the course of a number of consultations this delegation so far held with developing participants to the multilateral trade negotiations, it has come to the attention of this delegation that by some misunderstanding requests had been submitted on a number of items for the removal of discretionary licensing or quantitative restrictions that did not exist. I am attaching, therefore, a list of such items.¹
