INTERNATIONAL CONVENTIONS REGARDING  
INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND THEIR MEMBERSHIP

Note by the Secretariat

1. At its meeting of 10 June 1987, the Negotiating Group requested the secretariat to provide a document listing international conventions regarding intellectual property rights and their membership. This information is contained in Annexes I-III to this note.
2. Annex I presents in tabular form membership of the Convention Establishing the World Intellectual Property Organization (1967, amended in 1979) and of the following treaties providing for substantive protection of intellectual property:
