TROPICAL PRODUCTS

Communication by Cameroon, Côte d'Ivoire, Senegal and Zaire

The following communication, dated 21 October 1987, has been received from Cameroon, Côte d'Ivoire, Senegal and Zaire with the request that it be circulated to the members of the Group.

The four previous meetings of the Negotiating Group on Tropical Products gave us an opportunity to express, in general terms, our views regarding the objectives and conduct of the negotiations on tropical products.

In the light of the relevant provisions of the Ministerial Declarations of 1982, at Geneva, and 1986, at Punta del Este, and the United Nations Programme of Action for African Recovery and Development, as well as the Declaration adopted very recently at the conclusion of UNCTAD VII, the African countries consider that these four documents all represent solemn political commitments towards the adoption of measures to encourage their economic development.

Furthermore, considering the preferential treatment which they are recognized because most of them belong to the category of least-developed countries and also to the group of signatories of the Lomé Convention, the African countries expect contracting parties to respect their acquired rights and also to effect a substantial improvement in the trade régimes applicable to them.

To that end, they request developed contracting parties to undertake the fullest liberalization of tariff and non-tariff barriers affecting trade in tropical products according to the modalities outlined below.

In the framework of these proposals, the delegations of Zaire, Cameroon, Côte d'Ivoire and Senegal also submit the attached preliminary list of products of export interest to their countries. This list may be revised at a later stage, according to developments in the negotiations.

In conformity with the Ministerial Declaration, which provides that negotiations should aim at the fullest liberalization of trade in tropical products, including in their processed and semi-processed forms, the delegations of the above-mentioned countries propose the following:

Tariffs

I. Developed countries shall ensure that they:

- (a) harmonize tariffs applied to processed or semi-processed tropical products at the lowest rates existing in those countries. The harmonization formula adopted could be applied according to a timetable of reductions spread over a five-year period;
- (b) bind the tariff rates actually applied during the initial phase of the negotiations, in particular the free entry afforded to unprocessed tropical products.

II. Developed countries shall take full account of the preferential arrangements benefitting African countries and the special situation of Africa as recognized by the UNPAARD¹ and other relevant decisions of the United Nations systems. In this framework, they shall see to it that their preferential margins, in particular on behalf of the least-developed countries are maintained.

Market access

Developed contracting parties shall adopt specific measures to increase market access for tropical products, both by removing non-tariff barriers, in particular quantitative restrictions and phytosanitary regulations, and also by improving their generalized schemes of preferences.

1. Non-tariff measures

Developed countries shall undertake to:

- (a) abolish selective internal taxes maintained with regard to tropical products such as coffee, cocoa, tea and bananas; the elimination of these selective taxes is to be carried out at once upon conclusion of the negotiations;
- (b) introduce no new selective internal taxes on other tropical products;
- (c) eliminate global quotas and discretionary licensing affecting tropical products, as well as seasonal quotas imposed on certain tropical products; failing this, they shall endeavour to increase the volume and duration of all types of quota;
- (d) abolish prohibitions on imports of tropical products that compete with their domestic production;

- (e) abolish the obligation to take over part of their domestic production as well as minimum import price obligations, which considerably increase the cost of products of interest for developing countries, particularly when such products originate in LDCs;
- (f) ease and harmonize sanitary or technical standards applicable to tropical products.

2. Improvement of GSP schemes

Developed contracting parties shall see to improving their GSP schemes, in particular in the following ways:

- (a) inclusion of all African countries in the lists of GSP beneficiary countries;
- (b) inclusion of new products of interest in the coverage of GSP schemes, in particular for tropical products included in CCCN Chapters 1 to 24;
- (c) reduction of all positive GSP rates to zero;
- (d) abolition of "limiting" criteria for GSP application (in particular, so-called "sensitive" products, exclusion criteria based on limit amounts or market shares, or the percentage of the beneficiary country's GNP in relation to that of the preference-giving country, and a priori exclusion of countries for specific products);
- (e) non-imposition of quantitative limits such as ceilings and quotas in the granting of GSP concessions by developed countries;
- (f) improvement of rules of origin, taking account of "cumulative" origin among African countries, for processed or semi-processed tropical products. "Working" criteria should also be improved as regards processed products.

Least-developed countries

3. Besides improving their GSP schemes, developed countries shall take the following measures with respect to LDCs:

- (i) recognition of LDC status by developed States which have not yet done so;
- (ii) inclusion of additional products in GSP coverage in favour of LDCs.

TROPICAL PRODUCTS

Submission by Cameroon, Côte d'Ivoire,
Senegal and Zaïre

The following contains an initial list of tropical products of export interest to the submitting countries. The list is addressed to the eleven developed countries covered by the existing background material (which includes the EEC taken as one of them). The submitting countries intend to seek the fullest trade liberalization of tariff and all non-tariff measures affecting exports of these products, including in their semi-processed and processed forms in the framework of negotiations on tropical products. The listing of products is provided according to the Harmonized System code numbers, provisionally identified for the tropical products included therein. The submitting countries reserve their right to revise this list, and to add or withdraw any products before or during the negotiations.
