Note by the Secretariat

- 1. The Punta del Este Ministerial Declaration provides that the secretariat "may also provide further relevant information" on standstill and rollback notifications (MTN.DEC, final sentence of paragraph C).
- 2. At its first meeting on 26 February 1987, the Surveillance Body agreed to the Chairman's proposal that, as concerns standstill, "the secretariat could supply further relevant information about any action or measure covered by a notification such as, for example, its trade or country coverage, and that such information could be circulated to all participants" (MTN.SB/1, paragraph 21).
- 3. The information overleaf, relevant to the reverse notification on standstill by Chile concerning the United States (MTN.SB/SN/7), is provided by the secretariat.
