### Indicative List of Sectors of Interest to Hong Kong

Pursuant to the decision of Ministers in Montreal to invite participants to submit indicative lists of service sectors of interest to them, Hong Kong would like to put forward its contribution to the negotiating process in the area of trade in services. At Annex is an indicative list of service sectors of interest to Hong Kong.

In submitting this indicative list, Hong Kong would wish to reiterate its position on the sectoral coverage of any multilateral framework on trade in services. As agreed by Ministers in Montreal, no service sector should be excluded a priori from these negotiations. The Hong Kong indicative list merely sets out those sectors in which Hong Kong currently has a trading interest, be it import or export, and need not be either comprehensive or final. Hong Kong reserves the right to introduce revisions to the list in the light of subsequent negotiations on both coverage and other elements of the future multilateral framework for trade in services.
