The attached communications from the delegation of Australia containing responses to requests for trade information addressed by Ghana, Mexico, Myanmar, the United States and Senegal are circulated to the members of the Group.

TROPICAL PRODUCTS

Response to Indicative List From Ghana

In accordance with the procedures for negotiations adopted by the Negotiating Group on Tropical Products Australia provides the following response to the indicative list submitted by Ghana on 3 October 1988 (MTN.GNG/6/LT/36).

The response is drawn primarily from the comprehensive listing of Australia's contribution on tropical products (MTN.GNG/17 Attachment 1) tabled as part of the results agreed at the Ministerial Meeting in Montreal in December 1988.

The cuts announced by Australia involve tariff reductions on 70% of all dutiable imports of tropical products. These cuts mean that 56% (previously 28%) of Australia's total tropical products imports will be duty free.

In accordance with the outcome at Montreal, Australia is prepared to negotiate further liberalization of markets for tropical products. Australia is also prepared to negotiate bindings on all tropical products. This will depend on what other countries are prepared to do in areas of export interest to Australia. With regard to Tropical Products of interest to Australia, these have been identified in MTN.GNG/NG6/LT/2.

The following comments are provided on the specific issues raised by Ghana:

- . Tariff reductions are as attached.
- . Australian sanitary and phytosanitary regulations are necessary to protect Australia from injurious pests and diseases. Importation of plant and animal material into Australia is subject to such regulations. These measures have no trade protective purpose.
- . Packaging, labelling and market standards regulations are implemented in order to protect the community from controllable health hazards; prevent product misrepresentation, and provide necessary information to consumers. These measures have no trade protective purpose.

Response to Indicative List From Mexico

In accordance with the procedures for negotiations adopted by the Negotiating Group on Tropical Products Australia provides the following response to the indicative list submitted by Mexico on 6 June 1988 (MTN.GNG/NG6/LT/16).

The response is drawn from the comprehensive listing of Australia's contribution on tropical products (MTN.GNG/17 Attachment 1) tabled as part of the results agreed at the Ministerial Meeting in Montreal in December 1988. Without prejudice to the coverage of tropical products negotiations Australia has also provided information requested on products not included in MTN.GNG/17 Attachment 1.

The cuts announced by Australia involve tariff reductions on 70% of all dutiable imports of tropical products. These cuts mean that 56% (previously 28%) of Australia's total tropical products imports will be duty free.

In accordance with the outcome at Montreal, Australia is prepared to negotiate further liberalization of markets for tropical products. Australia is also prepared to negotiate bindings on all tropical products. This will depend on what other countries are prepared to do in areas of export interest to Australia. With regard to Tropical Products of interest to Australia, these have been identified in MTN.GNG/NG6/LT/2.

Response to Indicative List From Burma

In accordance with the procedures for negotiations adopted by the Negotiating Group on Tropical Products Australia provides the following response to the indicative list submitted by Burma in MTN.GNG/NG6/LT/13/Suppl.1 of 13 December 1988.

The response is drawn from the comprehensive listing of Australia's contribution on tropical products (MTN.GNG/17 Attachment 1) tabled as part of the results agreed at the Ministerial Meeting in Montreal in December 1988. Without prejudice to the coverage of tropical products negotiations Australia has also provided information requested on products not included in MTN.GNG/17 Attachment 1.

The cuts announced by Australia involve tariff reductions on 70% of all dutiable imports of tropical products. These cuts mean that 56% (previously 28%) of Australia's total tropical products imports will be duty free.

In accordance with the outcome at Montreal, Australia is prepared to negotiate further liberalization of markets for tropical products. Australia is also prepared to negotiate bindings on all tropical products. This will depend on what other countries are prepared to do in areas of export interest to Australia. With regard to Tropical Products of interest to Australia, these have been identified in MTN.GNG/NG6/LT/2.

TROPICAL PRODUCTS

Response to Indicative List From Senegal

In accordance with the procedures for negotiations adopted by the Negotiating Group on Tropical Products Australia provides the following response to the indicative list submitted by Senegal on 12 October 1988 (MTN.GNG/NG6/LT/41).

The response is drawn primarily from the comprehensive listing of Australia's contribution on tropical products (MTN.GNG/17 Attachment 1) tabled as part of the results agreed at the Ministerial Meeting in Montreal in December 1988.

The cuts announced by Australia involve tariff reductions on 70% of all dutiable imports of tropical products. These cuts mean that 56% (previously 28%) of Australia's total tropical products imports will be duty free.

In accordance with the outcome at Montreal, Australia is prepared to negotiate further liberalization of markets for tropical products. Australia is also prepared to negotiate bindings on all tropical products. This will depend on what other countries are prepared to do in areas of export interest to Australia. With regard to Tropical Products of interest to Australia, these have been identified in MTN.GNG/NG6/LT/2.

The following comments are provided on the specific issues raised by Senegal:

- . Tariff rates are as attached.
- . Australian sanitary and phytosanitary regulations are necessary to protect Australia from injurious pests and diseases. Importation of plant and animal material into Australia is subject to such regulations. These measures have no trade protective purpose.
- . Packaging, labelling and market standards regulations are implemented in order to protect the community from controllable health hazards; prevent product misrepresentation, and provide necessary information to consumers. These measures have no trade protective purpose.
