Additional Contributions by Malaysia

The following communication dated 17 October 1989 has been received from the delegation of Malaysia with the request that it be circulated to all participants. The communication contains additional contributions of Malaysia on tropical products.

At the meeting of the Negotiating Group on Tropical Products on 24-26 July 1989, Malaysia made an announcement concerning additional contributions to improve the results obtained on tropical products thus far. All such contributions should be given due credit and assessed in the overall results of the negotiations.
