Update to Note by the Secretariat

- 1. At the meeting of 5 April 1990, the Negotiating Group on Dispute Settlement requested the Secretariat to update its Note of 24 January 1990 on Discussions and Proposals in other Negotiating Groups and in the Code Committees relating to Dispute Settlement. In particular, the Group requested that the Secretariat indicate those proposals which clearly depart from GATT dispute settlement procedures, including proposals discussed in the Group, and those which depart but which are considered to be transitional in nature. This update is prepared in response to that request.
- 2. Of the documents mentioned in MTN.GNG/NG13/W/37 and MTN.GNG/NG13/W/37/Add.1 and Add.2, those which contain proposals that clearly depart from GATT dispute settlement procedures are the following:
 - in the Negotiating Group on Agriculture: MTN.GNG/NG5/W/144 and MTN.GNG/NG5/W/156.
 - in the Negotiating Group on GATT Articles: MTN.GNG/NG7/W/58, MTN.GNG/NG7/W/64 and MTN.GNG/NG7/W/67.
- 3. Of the documents mentioned in MTN.GNG/NG13/W/37 and MTN.GNG/NG13/W/37/Add.1 and Add.2, those which contain proposals that depart from GATT dispute settlement procedures but which are considered to be transitional in nature are the following:
