**Revised MFN Exemption List of Jamaica**

The following communication is circulated at the request of Jamaica to the members of the Group of Negotiations on Services.

---

1. Jamaica presents its list of MFN Exemptions from Article II of the General Agreement on Trade in Services (GATS) (Revision 1) of 29 October, 1993.
2. Jamaica reserves the right to modify, expand or amend its List of Exemptions in any way prior to the conclusion of the Uruguay Round.

**Exemptions Application to Specific Sectors or Sub-sectors**
