Signatories are Argentina, Brazil, Bolivia, Chile, Paraguay, Peru and Uruguay	Indefinite	The Convention is to facilitate transport among countries bordering the "Southern Cone" on the basis of reciprocal treatment for suppliers of these services.
Bilateral investment promotion and protection agreements	The provisions of these conventions guarantee investors from the other contracting party freedom to transfer and invest capital and other amounts related to investments. They also guarantee investors against the non-commercial risks to which their investment is exposed.	Countries with which Uruguay has investment promotion and protection agreements	Indefinite	Bilateral agreements to provide improved conditions of legal security for the investment of foreign capital in Uruguay.
